Ocean Safety

Lifeguards

Ocean Safety Officers (OSO), or lifeguards, are on duty every day from 8:00 am - 4:30 pm.

As part of the island-wide 9-1-1 Emergency System, all OSO are trained above and beyond USLA certifications and all are certified AHA First Responders. Each OSO is skilled in rescue techniques using equipment such as rescue boards, tubes and fins, jet skis, four-wheel drive ATVs, and first aid supplies.

Lifeguard Towers

- South Side: Kamaole 1, 2, 3 Beach Parks
- West Side: Hanakao'o Beach (a.k.a. Canoe Beach), DT Flemming Beach Park
- North Shore: Kanaha Beach Park, HA Baldwin Beach Park, and Ho'okipa Beach Park
- East Side: Hana Bay (fall months only)

Safety Tips

- If you are unable to swim out of a strong current, signal for help
- Rely on your swimming ability rather than a flotation device
- Look for, read, and obey all beach and safety signs
- If in doubt, don't go out!
- Protect the environment. Refrain from touching all reefs. Help keep the beaches clean and Hawaii beautiful.
- Swim in lifeguarded areas
- Never swim alone

- Do not dive into unknown water or into shallow breaking waves
- Do not attempt to dive over large waves
- Ask a lifeguard about beach and surf safety before swimming

Is your child with a disability prepared for life after high school? Are you interested in learning about programs and services that could help in this transition process? Then, make your way down to the Sixth Annual Big Mac (Moving Across Community) High School Transition Event that will be held on Thursday, February 13, 2014, at the Velma McWayne Santos Community Center (Wailuku Community Center), 395 Waena Place, Wailuku.

The event is sponsored by the Maui County Department of Parks and Recreation, Department of Education-Maui District, Community Children's Council of Maui, and the State Council on Developmental Disabilities. The event will feature a Disability Resource/ Job Fair from 3:00-5:00 p.m. There will be exhibits from over 27 agencies, including Maui Service Providers, Social Security, Voter Registration, Legal Aid, County Transportation, Employers, and much more.
